- I will respect and abide by the league rules and always play the game in the right spirit.
- I will celebrate effort and good play from both sides.
- I will be gracious in victory and defeat. Win or lose I will encourage team members to enjoy every moment and promote learning and development over match results.
- I will not use foul or other inappropriate language.
- I will be prepared for training sessions and competitions and ensure the club's equipment is fit for purpose.
